Launch of the Roos Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund 2017

**The Fund is open for applications from 1 December 2016 until 31 March 2017.
The decision-making panel, made up of representatives from the area of benefit, will
then meet in May 2017**

RES, the British independent renewable energy company that developed the nine turbine wind farm, has established a Community Fund to provide £36,000 per year (index linked) to support local community projects during the lifetime of the wind farm.

Applications from charitable and community organisations are now invited for the 2017 fund, which is the fourth year of the funds.

Completed applications to the Fund must demonstrate that their activities will benefit the communities living and working within 5km of Roos Post Office.

This area includes the parishes of Burton Pidsea, Rimswell, Halsham and Roos.
