

ROOS PARISH, which includes the settlements of Tunstall, Hilston and Owstwick, benefits from three Wind Farm Renewable Energy Company Community Funds:

- **Roos Wind Farm** (operated by RES (Renewable Energy Systems))
- **Tedder Hill Wind Farm** (operated by INFINIS)
- **Burton Pidsea Wind Farm** (operated by Energiekontor)

The area of benefit and the arrangements for the management of each fund is different.

For example:

Roos Wind Farm Community Fund is managed by a Community Interest Company with local and community based directors, administration being provided by the East Riding Voluntary Action Services (ERVAS) <http://www.ervas.org.uk/> The fund receives an annual grant of around £36,000.

Tedder Hill Wind Farm Community Fund has received a 'one-off' grant of £100,000 with an annual payment of £5000 and is administered by the ERYC.

Potential financial benefit:

Roos Wind Farm	£36,000 per annum
Burton Pidsea Wind Farm	£24,000 per annum
Tedder Hill Wind Farm	£100,000 lump sum, and, subsequently, £5000 per annum

As each fund has different terms of reference, it is suggested that Community Groups and other interested parties should evaluate which fund is most applicable for their needs. It is possible to make bids to each of the funds.
